JAMES MADISON, *President of the United States of America,*

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

**Know ye,** *That George Fisher of Washington County, Pennsylvania,*

*having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at Steubenville whereby it appears that he has made full payments for the Northwest Quarter of Section number Ten, of Township number Eleven, in Range number Five,*

*of the lands directed to be sold at Steubenville,*  
by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same, **There is granted,** by the United States, unto the said *George Fisher, the Quarter,* lot or section of land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *Quarter,* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *George Fisher his* heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, *I have caused these letters to be made Patent,*  
and the seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of Washington, the *thirtieth*  
day of *December* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *eleven* and of the Independence of the United States of America, the thirty-sixth.
